### Privacy Statement of [www.debrauw-blic.com](http://www.debrauw-blic.com)

This is the Privacy Statement of the website [www.debrauw-blic.com](http://www.debrauw-blic.com) (Website). This Privacy Statement provides information on the processing of personal data of the users of the Website (Users) by De Brauw Blackstone Westbroek N.V., based at Claude Debussylaan 80, 1082 MD Amsterdam (De Brauw).

### 1. When is this Privacy Notice applicable?

This Privacy Statement is applicable to the processing of all personal data of Users through the Website by De Brauw.

### 2. Who is the controller of your data?

De Brauw is the controller for the processing of your personal data. De Brauw has notified the Dutch Data Protection Authority (DDPA) in The Hague of its processing of personal data. The notification indicates what data are processed by De Brauw and for what purpose, and to which persons or entities the data will be provided.

### 3. For what purpose do we process your personal data?

(1) If you have consented to this, for sending you updates about De Brauw Legal Innovation Challenge (De BLIC).

- What does this purpose entail?

We would like to keep you updated on the latest developments on De BLIC. We will do this by means of e-newsletters. If you would like to stay informed on these topics, you can indicate this by sending an e-mail to [info@debrauw-blic.com](mailto:info@debrauw-blic.com).

- Which personal data do we process for this purpose?

For this purpose we process your name, your e-mail address and an overview of which e-newsletters we have sent you.

- For what period do we retain your personal data?

We retain your personal data for as long as you wish to receive information on De BLIC. In case you don't want to receive our e-mails anymore, you can unsubscribe at any time by contacting us on [info@debrauw-blic.com](mailto:info@debrauw-blic.com) or by using the unsubscribe option included in each e-mail message from De Brauw.



## (2) For answering your questions or responding to your comments.

- What does this purpose entail?  
Via the contact details provided on the Website, you can ask us a question. In this case we will use your personal data to answer your question.
- Which personal data do we process for this purpose?  
For this purpose we process your name, the contact details you provided (e-mail address and telephone number), your correspondence with De Brauw about your question or comment and all other personal data you provide us with and which is required to answer your question.
- For what period do we retain your personal data for this purpose?  
Your data will be deleted from our systems after De BLIC has ended on 1 June 2017.

## (3) For your participation in De BLIC.

- What does this purpose entail?  
We need your personal data to be able to inform you about the progress of De BLIC, to announce the winners and to distribute the prize.
- Which personal data do we process for this purpose?  
For this purpose we use your name, contact details you provided (email address and telephone number), your correspondence with De Brauw, the University or University of applied science you are submitted to and your student number, to register entries, to inform about the progress and to announce the winners. We need your bank account details to distribute the prize.
- For what period do we retain your personal data?  
We store your personal data until De BLIC has ended on 1 June 2017. The personal data of the winner will be stored until the prize has been distributed and there are no any further issues.

## 4. Who has access to your data?

De Brauw uses third parties for certain processings, such as Website hosting. As far as these third parties have access to personal data in order to execute these processings, De Brauw has taken the required organizational and contractual measures to ensure that your personal data is exclusively processed for the purposes mentioned above. Only if De Brauw is required to do so by law, your personal data will be provided to supervisory agencies, fiscal authorities and investigative agencies.
